**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE  
BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS AND SURIGAO STATE COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY  
LIBRARY**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:**

This Agreement, made and executed by and between:

The **BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS**, a government instrumentality duly organized and existing by virtue of Republic Act No. 7653, with principal office address at the Bangko Sentral Complex, A. Mabini corner P. Ocampo Sr. Streets, Malate 1004, Manila, duly represented by its Officer-In-Charge, **FELICITAS C. CONCHA**, hereinafter referred to as "**BSP**";

- and -

**SSCT LIBRARY**, a pursuant to Republic Act 8650, 1998 with principal office address at the Narciso Street, Surigao City, duly represented by its Head Librarian, **IVY B. MABANTO**, hereinafter referred to as "**SURIGAO STATE COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY LIBRARY**."

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the **BSP** recognizes that access to economic and financial information is one of the key elements in achieving the success of the National Strategy for Financial Inclusion;

**WHEREAS**, the **BSP** aims, as one of its major advocacies, to enhance the public's understanding of the fundamental economic and financial concepts and issues affecting the economic development of the country;

**WHEREAS**, the **BSP** publishes books, reports, journals and in-house magazines on economic and financial matters and disseminates them to promote its Economic and Financial Learning Program and greater transparency in its operations;

**WHEREAS**, the **SSCT LIBRARY** as a public library, continuously acquires information resources to meet the research and information needs of its academic community;

**WHEREAS**, the **SSCT LIBRARY** recognizes that it is mutually beneficial to exchange and share information resources and services to satisfy the research information requirements of its clientele;

**WHEREAS**, the **BSP Knowledge Resource Network** is a program assisting the public by promoting the understanding of the essential economic and financial concepts and issues affecting the country's economy, through the exchange of information resources between and among its network members;

**WHEREAS**, as a collaborative effort, both parties recognize the benefits of participating in the BSP Knowledge Resource Network;

**WHEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

**UNDERTAKINGS OF THE BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS**

1. Establish and maintain BSP Knowledge Resource Collections, a space within the library premises of the BSP Knowledge Resource Network member with available BSP print materials such as books, annual reports, inflation reports, statistical publications, brochures, pamphlets, posters and other information/learning materials, as well as online materials through the BSP website;
2. Link network members' portals with the BSP website in order to access BSP's online publications and other information resources;
3. Assist network members with their research and reference inquiries regarding economic and financial information, particularly in the areas of economics, banking, finance and investments, subject to existing applicable laws, regulations and internal policies of BSP;
4. Conduct briefings of designated librarians from Network member-libraries on the nature of information resources and services available at Economic and Financial Learning Center (EFLC) of the BSP Butuan Branch, including the BSP website; and
5. Conduct periodic review and evaluation of the effectiveness of the program.

**UNDERTAKINGS OF THE SURIGAO STATE COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY LIBRARY**

1. Provide the space, staff, furniture, shelves and IT equipment needed for display and use of BSP publications at the designated BSP Knowledge Resource Collection;
2. Catalog all BSP publications provided and make them discoverable on their library systems and available for use by library clients;
3. Designate a librarian that will serve as "Reference Librarian" who shall be: (i) the main contact person of the network member with EFLC of the BSP Caraga Branch; (ii) available for briefing/training on the nature of EFLC information resources and services provided; and (iii) responsible in coordinating requests for reference and research assistance originating from the network member that designated her.
4. Monitor usage of BSP Information materials and research requests filled and submit quarterly reports to EFLC Main Office, including feedback from the users, not later than the last working day of each quarter.

This Agreement shall take effect on the date the parties have signed the same as indicated below their signatures. If the parties signed on different dates, the date of execution of this Agreement shall be the later date.

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_, 2020 between the

**DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY- CARAGA**, with office address at CSU, CAMPUS, AMPAYON, BUTUAN CITY represented in this Agreement by its Regional Director, **DOMINGA D. MALLONGA, CESO III**, herein referred to as the **"FIRST PARTY"**;

**SURIGAO STATE COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY – SURIGAO CITY CAMPUS**, with office address at Narciso Street, Brgy. Taft, Surigao City represented herein by its College President, **Dr. GREGORIO Z. GAMBOA, JR.**, hereinafter referred to as the **"SECOND PARTY"**;

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **FIRST PARTY**, promotes and implements ICT related projects for the advancement of **DOST-CARAGA** and recognizes the benefits of establishing **STARBOOKS** in the Region;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY**, is mandated to enhance education by providing holistic and quality co-curricular program, projects and activities that will prepare the Filipino children and youth towards the new millennium and to deliver quality, effective, and efficient delivery of educational services.

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement, considering their respective mandates, resources and expertise, networks and programs and, desirous of accomplishing a better coordinated, shared, more impact-producing project have agreed to work together to accomplish this objective to commence on February 17, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and in pursuance of their desire to cooperate in a defined area and in recognition of shared interest in strengthening cooperation on science and technology information and activities on the basis of mutual benefits, the **FIRST** and **SECOND PARTY** have reached the following agreement:


### GENERAL AGREEMENT

1.1 Subject to their respective rights and obligations as set out in this Agreement, the Parties shall cooperate and endeavor to achieve the following:

### OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY

2.1 The First Party shall, for its exclusive account, timely, properly and adequately perform the following:

(a) Responsible for the installation of content updates from the **DOST-STII**.



(b) Responsible for the mandatory training of STARBOOKS Technology administrator of the SECOND PARTY for the operation of the such;


#### **OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY**

3.1 The Second Party shall, for its exclusive account, timely, properly and adequately perform the following:

- (a) Provide a computer for the STARBOOKS Technology;
- (b) Provide the Computer with an estimated amount of \_\_\_\_\_, access terminal and other computer devices needed;
- (c) Provide two (2) point persons (preferably librarian and IT staff) to manage the operations and sustainability of the STARBOOKS project;
- (d) Provide supplies and materials needed for the operations of the STARBOOKS Technology;
- (e) Ensure that all proper safety and security measures are followed during the preparations for and actual implementation, if applicable
- (f) Submit monthly accomplishment/progress report (log usage statistics/problems met/ comments and suggestions to improve the system) every 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month to DOST-STII. The SECOND PARTY will cease to receive an updated digitized content and upgraded version should it fail to submit the monthly reports for three (3) consecutive months to the DOST-STII;

#### **MISCELLANEOUS CONDITIONS**

- 4.1 Safety Measures. The FIRST PARTY shall ensure that all proper safety and security measures are followed during the preparations for and actual implementation of this undertaking.
- 4.2 Intellectual Property. The Parties hereto agree not to violate each other's intellectual property rights consisting of, but not limited to their respective trademarks, copyrights, patents and design, and utility model rights. The parties also recognize the validity and enforceability of these rights and shall not dispute nor challenge the same at any time.
- 4.3 Relationship of the Parties. There is no employer-employee relationship between the FIRST and SECOND PARTY and the latter's officers, employees, agents or representatives who may be assigned to perform the services under this Agreement. It is agreed that FIRST PARTY shall be solely responsible for the respective compensation of said officers, employees, agents or representatives who may be assigned to perform the services under this Agreement. As such, the FIRST PARTY shall hold the SECOND PARTY free from any liability, cause/s of action, claim/s FIRST PARTY's officers, employees, agents or representatives in connection with the services they are assigned to perform under this Agreement or under the provisions of the Labor Code of the Philippines and such other applicable laws, rules, and regulations.



**4.4 Force Majeure.** The term "Force Majeure/fortuitous event" shall mean all events which could not be foreseen or although foreseen, were inevitable and beyond the control of the Party/ies, and which materially affect the ability of the Party/ies to comply with any of its/their obligations under this Agreement, and shall include, among others, acts of war or the public enemy (whether declared or not), fire, earthquake, flood, typhoons, public disorders, sabotage, rebellion, revolution, civil commotion, strikes, lockouts, boycotts or other industrial or labor disputes, acts, orders and rulings of Government, whether national or local, or any of its agencies and instrumentality, which may adversely affect the performance of the respective obligations or the exercise of the respective rights of the Parties, and which could not be attributed to the fault, negligence and participation of the Party/ies and/or their respective agents/employees, or any other cause or causes, whether similar or dissimilar to the foregoing, which are beyond the reasonable control of the Party/ies.

In cases of Force Majeure/fortuitous events and/or when public interest/welfare so demands, the FIRST and SECOND PARTY shall have the right and authority to suspend the implementation of this Agreement or any portion hereof without incurring any liability therefore to the FIRST PARTY and without being deemed to be in breach of this Agreement, upon giving reasonable notice thereof to the FIRST PARTY. Once the event of Force Majeure or fortuitous event has already ceased, the SECOND PARTY's duly-authorized representative shall immediately notify the FIRST PARTY of said event of Force Majeure, and the Parties shall evaluate whether to continue implementation of the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement.

**4.5 Authority of Signatories.** The signatories hereunder represent and warrant that all necessary corporate and other approvals for the execution of this Agreement by the "Parties", respectively, have been duly obtained.


**4.6 Non-Assignability.** This Memorandum of Agreement shall not be assigned by either Party, in whole or in part, without the other Party's prior written consent. Any assignment in contravention of this provision shall be null and void.

**4.7 Restrictions on Use and Transfer of STARBOOKS or the DOST Science Digital Library Technology.** The DOST-STII is the owner of the design and contents of the DOST Digital Science Library Technology.

The SECOND PARTY SHOULD NOT COPY, MODIFY, DECOMPILE, DISASSEMBLE, REVERSE ENGINEER, MERGE, OR TRANSFER THE DESIGN AND CONTENTS OF THE DOST DIGITAL SCIENCE LIBRARY TECHNOLOGY IN WHOLE OR IN PART. Neither it be distributed to others or transferred electronically from one computer to another over a network or used on any multi-terminal computer system.

STARBOOKS stickers (if any) will be strategically placed on the server of the kiosk for security purposes. In case of server failure or other technical problems, the FIRST PARTY shall be notified and if necessary, present during repair and troubleshooting activities, in cases when server failure or technical problems are beyond SECOND PARTY'S ability to repair and troubleshoot.

IF THE SECOND PARTY TRANSFER POSSESSION OF ANY COPY, MODIFICATION, OR MERGED PORTION OF THE DESIGN AND CONTENTS OF THE KIOSK TO ANOTHER PARTY, OR SERVER STICKERS (if any) WILL BE TAMPERED, THIS AGREEMENT IS AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATED FOLLOWING THE PRINCIPLES OF DUE PROCESS.



5.8 Promotion of STARBOOKS. The SECOND PARTY shall assist in the promotion of STARBOOKS.

5.9 Notices. All notices and communications which may be given to either of the Parties hereunder, shall be in writing, addressed and deemed properly given if sent by registered mail with return receipt, postage prepaid to the signatories and addresses specified in the first page of this Agreement, or to such other address/es as maybe designated by the Party/ies in subsequent written notice/s.

5.10 Non-waiver. The failure of one Party to insist upon the strict performance of any term, condition and/or covenant hereof shall not be deemed a relinquishment or waiver of any subsequent breach of or non-compliance with the same or any other term, condition and/or covenant hereof. No waiver by any one Party of its rights under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been made unless expressed clearly and in writing and signed by said Party.

5.11 Governing Law. This Agreement shall be interpreted, governed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

5.12 Amicable Settlement. The Parties agree that in the event any dispute of difference arising out of this Agreement or in the interpretation of any of the provisions hereof, the respective signatories of the "Parties" shall promptly meet to resolve such dispute or difference and the joint decision of such signatories shall be binding upon the Parties hereto.

5.13 Entire Agreement and Amendments. This Agreement and any other provisions or terms specifically incorporated herein constitute the entire agreement of the Parties. This Agreement may be amended only by an instrument in writing signed by all the Parties. The terms, provisions and covenants of any such amendment/s shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the Parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

5.14 Effectivity. This Agreement shall take effect upon its execution by the Parties.



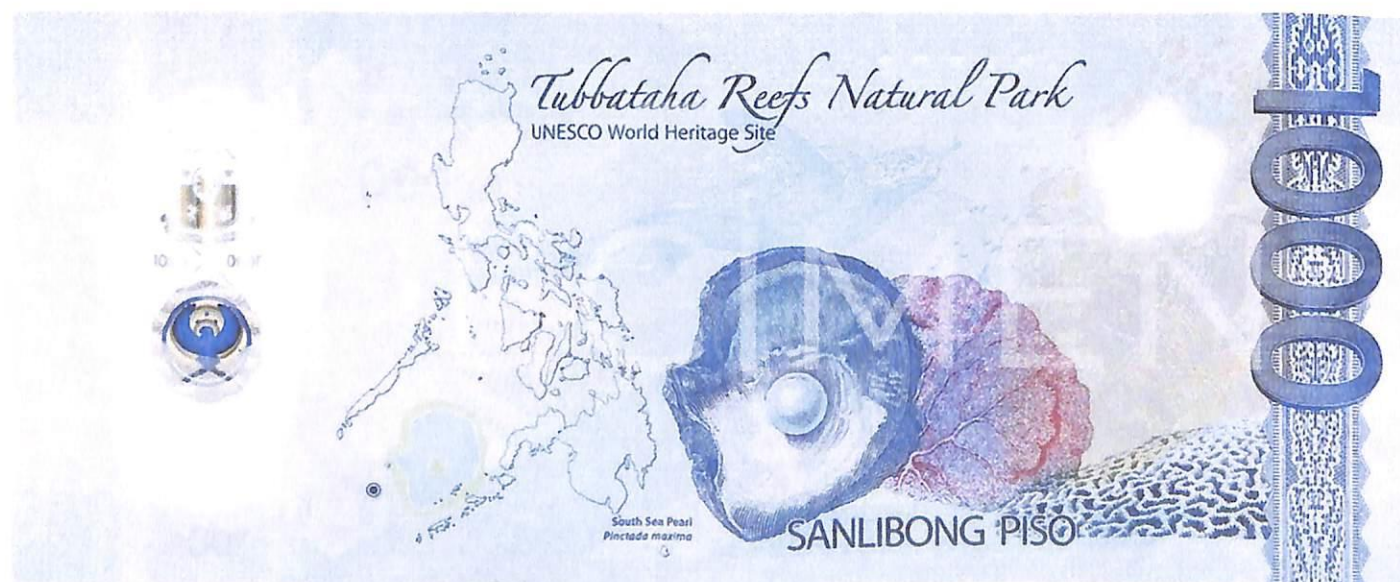

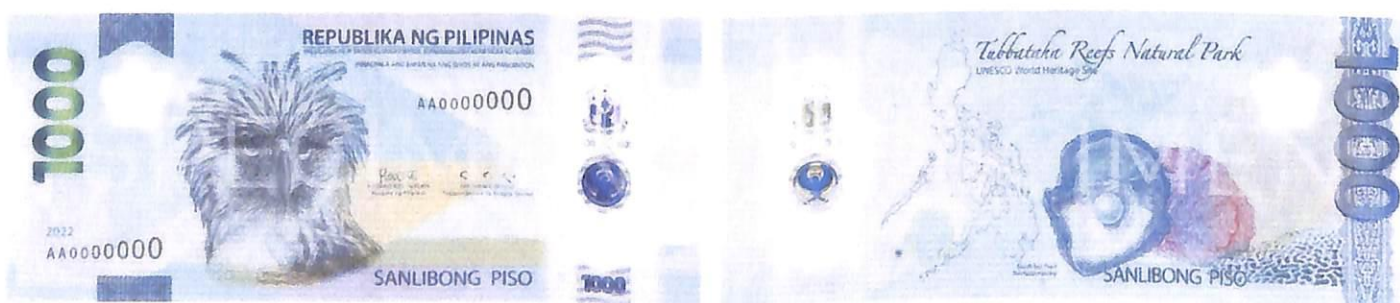

1000-Piso Polymer Banknote (obverse)



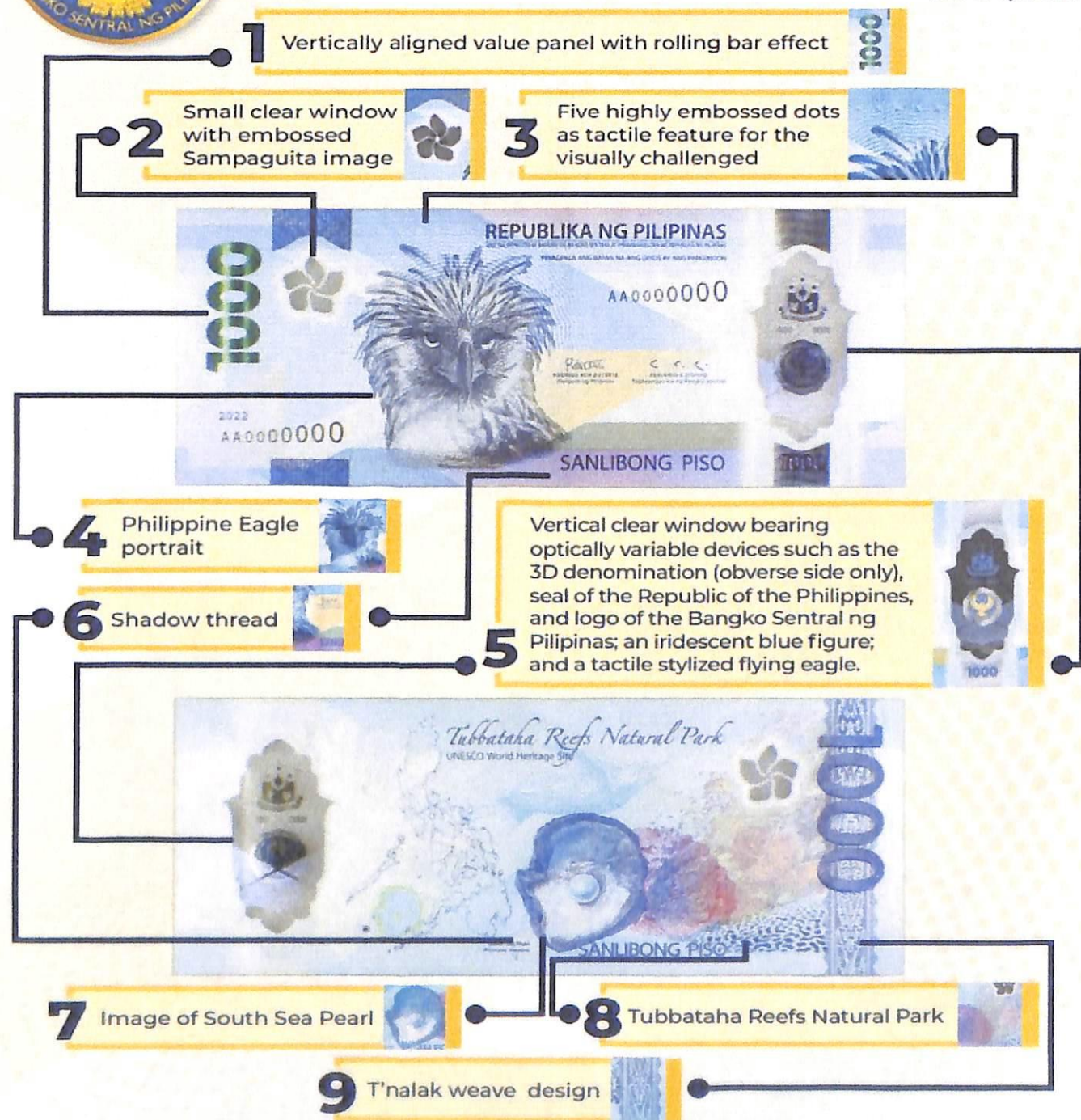
1000-Piso Polymer Banknote (reverse)

Reverse Design Highlights: Tubbataha Reefs Natural Park (UNESCO World Heritage Site), South Sea Pearl (*Pinctada maxima*), and Tnalak weave design

### 1 Polymer Substrate

**FEEL** the smooth surface. The banknote is one continuous sheet with transparent areas.



### 2 Enhanced Value Panel

**TILT** the note from left to right, and vice versa, to see the rolling-bar effect.



### 3 Sampaguita Clear Window

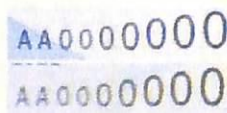
**LOOK** through the small transparent window depicting the Sampaguita (*Jasminum sambac*).

**FEEL** the transparent embossed line structures with the text "BSP" inside the flower on the front face of the note.



### 4 Serial Numbers

**LOOK** for two (2) identical serial numbers composed of 2 prefix letters and 7 asymmetric (increasing in size) digits.



### 5 Tactile Dots

**FEEL** the five highly embossed dots intended to assist the elderly and the visually impaired.



### 6 Embossed Prints

**FEEL** the raised ink that is rough to the touch.

**Front:** Philippine Eagle portrait, "REPUBLIKA NG PILIPINAS", signatures, and the amount in words

**Back:** Philippine map, South Sea Pearl, "Tubbataha Reefs Natural Park," Tnalak weave design, denomination, and the amount in words



### 7 Shadow Thread

**LOOK** for the 5-mm vertical band on either side of the note when viewed against the light. The denominational value and "BSP" text appear in repeated series.



### 8 Vertical Clear Window

**LOOK** through the large transparent vertical window containing multiple security features.



### 9 Metallic Features

**LOOK** at the details of metallic images and symbols in the vertical clear window.

**TILT** the note to see color changes and dynamic motion.

**Dynamic Waves.** Wavy lines on the front face of the note move when it is tilted back and forth.

**Republic of the Philippines (RP) Seal and Mirrored Denomination.** Both show moving vertical-line effects when the note is tilted back and forth.

**Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) Logo and 3D Denomination.**

On the **front**, the BSP logo and 3D denomination outline display a striking rainbow effect when the note is tilted at different angles. On the **back**, only the BSP logo is visible.



### 10 Blue Iridescent Figure

**TILT and LOOK** to see the figure that displays varying tones of blue when the note is viewed at different angles.



### 11 Flying Eagle

**FEEL** the transparent embossed outline of a stylized flying eagle.

### PURPOSES OF THIS GUIDE

- o To serve as a starting point for faculty and students doing research in economics and finance To make it easier for KRN partner librarians and their clientele to find free economic data and information resources online through the internet;
- o To expand the collections of KRN partner libraries with free, high quality, peer reviewed scholarly publications updated on a regular basis.

### SCOPE OF THE GUIDE

### OPEN-ACCESS (OA) : DEFINITION



Information content made freely and universally available via the Internet in easy to read format, usually because the publisher maintains online archives to which access is free or has deposited the information in a widely known open access repository. (ODLIS)



Open Access means free access to scholarly literature on the internet without financial, legal or technical barriers while authors retain legal control over their publication.
