The College Nurse, was tasked to explain very well to our new students the Medical and Dental services offered by the College Clinic.



The Director for Student Affairs, Ms. Maria Fe C. Guerra, discussed all the things students need to know about student discipline inside the campus.





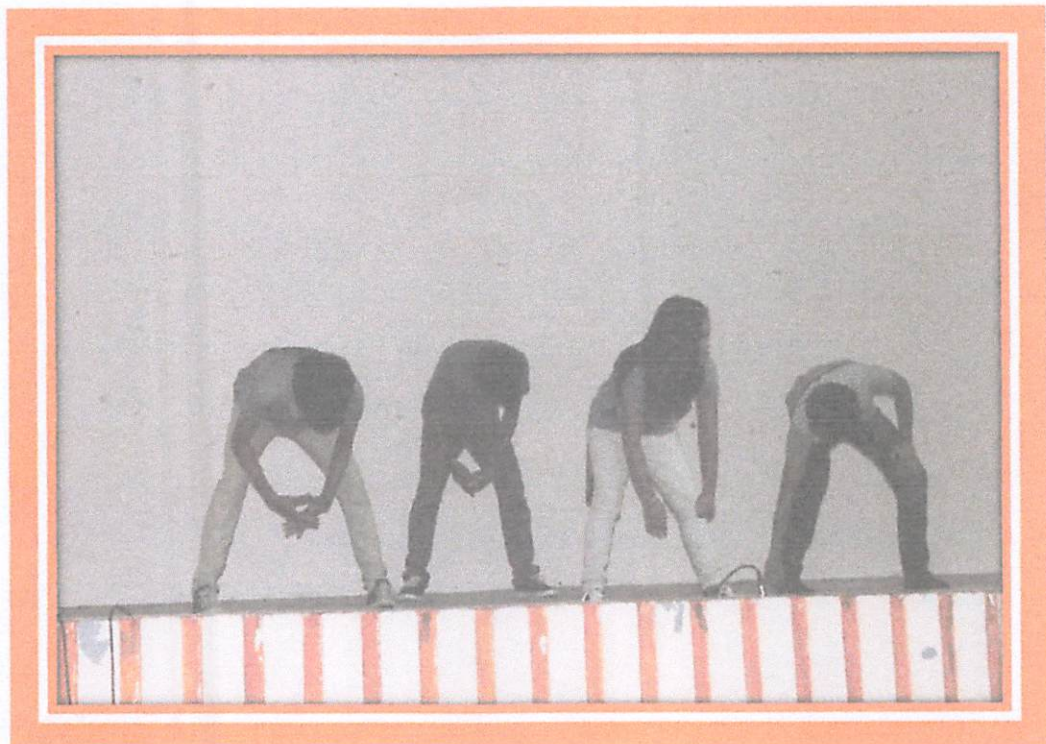
